

I have been looking forward to writing this month's newsletter about what God is doing with the giving from the folks at New Hope Church in Palm Harbor, Florida. This offering was earmarked to help Pastor Samuel Mtaula in Tete, Mozambique, Africa. What a blessing to play a part in God's grand plan for Mozambique and the surrounding countries! As I look back at how this all came about, I can clearly see the hand of God at work. At the time, however, I had no idea what was in store or how God would put things together.

This all began when I was in Malawi and having breakfast in the hotel dining room where I was staying. There was only one other man in the room at the time, a man from Malawi that I had never met. The Holy Spirit told me to introduce myself to him and ask if I could join him for breakfast. We exchanged info about what had brought each of us to Blantyre. After I shared that I was a missionary there helping to start a Bible training center, he got all excited as he had a brother in Mozambique who was a pastor. He thought his brother would be interested in our CTC program. It was only a few days after that breakfast meeting that Priest Evangelist Samuel Mtaula contacted me by email and invited me to Mozambique.

As we began to correspond, I asked Stephen Tambuli, our Malawi director, to make a trip there to see what was needed. Stephen reported that the congregation was in a church made of black plastic material, the kind that's used for garbage bags. When I saw the photos, I was deeply touched that people would attend such a facility and sit in the dirt to hear the gospel. Pastor Samuel asked me if I could help them with the children's ministry. New Hope Church's children responded with a love offering to help them get started.

Later, when God spoke to me about helping to build at least nine churches in 2018, I knew that Mozambique would be one of them. After God had miraculously supplied the money for the churches, I made a trip with Stephen Tambuli to Tete, Mozambique. There I would meet Pastor Samuel and give him some money and the plans for a new church building. The plans called for a 60' x 30' building made of brick with a sheet metal roof and cement floor; it would be quite a nice build-

ing and one they already had land to put it on. Four of us men stood on the property and released God to have His way on the property and in the church.

A few weeks later, Pastor Samuel emailed me saying that as much as he appreciated the gift and encouragement, he was feeling that the plans we had given him were not what God wanted him to do. He went on to say that his church was growing fast and that he expected they could have well over 1000 people by Christmas 2018 if they had adequate space. He asked for my permission to believe God for a much larger facility and to use the money we provided as seed to get them started.

I had no idea of the size of the building he had envisioned until recently when he sent me some photos of the brick outline of the building and a video to ask people to help them complete the project. I am going to try to share that video with you as best I can. I have gone through the video, made a script from Pastor Samuel's words, and periodically taken "screen shots" from the video to put with his words. Prayerfully, you will get the idea as you read along with the photos.

"Receive my greetings in the mighty name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. I want to share with you the time that I have been with the Lord. It is very, very im-

portant and very wonderful. I started with God in the house where I was staying. I went outside after I sold my car to start this ministry. I started in this





place for almost one year, praying.

After that, God continued to bless and we

changed the building. As you can see, the first building



was made of plastic papers, and after that, we changed into this building made of "mats." (This is

the present building which is in the front yard of the home he is renting and living with his family.)



Then by the grace of God, I came to



know RevC, and by the power of God his heart was touched and he began to help us build a church. As you see, we are constructing this big

church, and it takes a lot of money. RevC is helping us, but we need a lot more people to help us. When you talk about the



work of God, you will see that there are less people, but when you talk about "football," there are many

people who will give their money to games and other activities that are not the work of God. I am here to appeal to people who can be touched, who can help us to come up with this project, and to continue to preach the gospel of the Lord Jesus here in Mozambique. Mozambique is one of the countries that does not believe there is a God. So it is our responsibility to preach the gospel



to let people know that God exists. When we preach the gospel, people learn to love one another, and eventually we will have peace.

We need people who can be touched, and together we can manage, but us alone we cannot. So we are asking you by the grace of God; even the smallest amount of money that you can give for the construction of this building can make a difference. Let it be mentioned that any amount of money, any type of assistance that you



are going to help for the completion of this big project, this house of God, this spiritual center, will be where a lot of people come from different countries to receive salvation, to hear the Word of God, to hear the Word of Truth that will set them free. Thank you for the help, and God bless you in Jesus' mighty name." I am planning a trip to Mozambique in March. If you would like to help Pastor Samuel, please mark your gift "Mozambique." I have been at home more than normal due to the baby, mom's health, and many hours working on the online version of CTC. Hopefully, the online version should be operational in English before I travel.

I want to update you on the "Myanmar Miracle" project. We are releasing God to help us raise \$25,000 to train 10 pastors in this Buddhist country. So far we have received \$2600; thank you Jesus & those who have given. Here are two good investments that you can make in missions. Please ask the Lord what you can do. Thank you for standing with us and know we earnestly need your financial help and prayers!
