We passed the 4000 graduates mark when our CTC program in Nicaragua had two more groups graduate. This in a communist country!! PTL!!





CMA, MVI, and ITM Provide Motorcycles to Pastors The Christian Motorcycle Association each year provides funding to Missionary Ventures International for the advancement of the gospel, mainly by supplying motorcycles to pastors. ITM's relationship with MVI allows us to request funding for motorcycles for those who will put them to good use in advancing God's Kingdom. Our CTC director, Dr. George Kurenji, put the following pastors forward and were approved. These ten pastors represent six different countries in Africa: Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, DR Congo, Rwanda, and Burundi. In the first two months after receiving their motorcycles, they reported a combined number of 393 first time decisions for Christ largely made possible because they are now able to reach farther in their ministries. They were chosen as CTC graduates who have already shown their determination to make a difference in God's Kingdom. As God reminds you, please remember to pray for them. These Pastors are



















overseers of oth-



er churches besides the ones they pastor directly. Together they oversee 55 churches. They also reported a combined two-month total of 245 new members added to their respective churches! The motorcycles have definitely already proven to be a great blessing!

## "NO AFRICA TRAVEL FOR THE TIME BEING"

With the desire to start a new CTC program in Lomé, Togo, and all that is going on in Malawi, I was getting anxious to put together a trip. However, today I spent a couple of hours trying to arrange flights on Delta and United with connecting flights between Lomé and Blantyre, Malawi. A similar trip I had booked prior to the Covid shutdown was just over \$2100 total which included flying Delta comfort class on the longer flights. Today flying economy coach on Delta was near \$3000 and the connecting flights were another \$1000. Even worse, traveling from Lomé to Blantyre was going to take more than 24 hours, meaning an extra day layover somewhere. On the return trip, it would be over 40 hours, arriving two days later. The issue of having to have a negative Covid test result prior to each flight added to the problem. There are simply not enough airlines flying enough flights. Even Delta was code-sharing the greatest portion of the trip. So, until that situation improves, it is just not cost effective to travel to Africa.

In the meantime, I am still working on the CTC Online curriculum and now am in the last semester. Hopefully by the time I can fly to Africa, the curriculum will be finished and ready to upload to the worldwide web. I will look into the needs we have for travel to Central and South America which may be more doable.

## WE SERVE A MIRACLE WORKING GOD!

In the May newsletter, we gave God praise for helping us provide a total of \$20,000 toward the \$32,000 needed to put the roof structure in place for Pastor Samuel's

mega church in Mozambique and for the funds that came in from the April newsletter challenge to build two new churches in Malawi for Pastors Dennis Chaima and Stafford Sato. We also thank God that we were able to finish the roof for Pastor Francis along with funding to repair our truck that is used for hauling most of the building materials for all the new churches in Malawi. I sent Stephen over a \$1000 to cover the immediate repairs and balance toward future repairs. THANK YOU!

Then God worked a miracle of supply unlike any time before! The June newsletter was a step of faith to believe God to do what seemed almost impossible given the amount of funds that had been given in response to the May newsletter. In June, I challenged you to help build three new churches from the ground up and to finish two that were already under construction. I estimated that would take around \$40,000. For God, that amount is just a number. For me, however, it is a lot of money, especially in light of what had been given in May. I took the June newsletter to the post office in Clearwater on May 28th. From there, the post office takes them to the bulk mail distribution center in Tampa and generally the newsletters would go out the next day.

When I got home, I sat down at my computer to check my emails. There was an email from one of our ministry partners saying, in short, that the Lord had been speaking to her to do something sizeable toward building some churches. She wanted to know if we had a need. I decided to send her via email a PDF of the newsletter I just took to the post office. She quickly responded and asked how much would be needed. I must admit it brought me to tears, God is so good!

Today, I received a check for \$40,000.00 which should cover most of this need as well as provide some funds for travel when it is feasible to do so. Since then, I have been in contact with Stephen in Malawi. He indicated that of the two buildings that were already under construction, one is an adequate size but the other is only about half of what is needed. Thus, for that building, we will double its size and then finish out both.

I am sure you realize that God is using us in a very special way to glorify Himself before many people that do not know Him. I want to thank each of you who have sacrificed and continue to do so to keep this ministry moving forward accomplishing things I never dreamed were possible. To God be the Glory! Let's do MORE!! TOGETHER WE'RE MAKING A DIFFERENCE!
