Malawi Grads Step Out in Faith & God works a Miracle



Stephen Tambuli, our CTC director in the southern part of Malawi, has been visiting some of our recent graduates to see what they are doing with their training. Here is some of what he has reported:



Pastor Raphael Muwa, a 33-year-old young man who has just completed his diploma at Jali CTC in Zomba, answered the call of God to start a church in Kabwele village, his home village. He was able to purchase a piece of land for the church and then undertook the responsibility for

building the church with his own hands. Humble as this may seem to us in the USA with our multimillion-dollar facilities, Pastor Raphael has more than 40 people who have come to faith in Christ and are continuing to grow in number as they share the love and faithfulness of our Lord Jesus Christ.



The work started in February of this year despite COVID-19 and many other challenges. He has shown himself faithful to the calling God has on his life.

One additional part of his ministry that has separated him from many others is that their ministry is supporting orphans and the elderly who are unable to care for themselves. This

MIRACLE HEALING BIRTHS CHURCH

Pastor John Kawalanga from Zomba, pictured below with his family, completed his CTC program and felt God's leading to reach out to

Muslims living in his area in Chinseu village.

From January through March, he faithfully sought out individuals hoping to be able to share Christ and lead them to salvation. However, with all his effort not even one Muslim was open to accepting Jesus as their savior.



Then it happened that when a Muslim woman became seriously ill, the family sought every possible means to find a cure for the sickness. In spite of all they tried, nothing was making any difference. The family was so distraught that someone from the family came to John and asked him if he would come and pray for the dear woman as a last resort. As you might already expect, God heard his prayer and miraculously healed her, opening the door for more than 20 Muslims to come to faith in Christ. The family was so grateful that they gave John a piece of land measuring 260' by 100' for him to build a church.

This is the very first Christian church in this Muslim area. As most of the villagers are illiterate, he has started literacy classes so that

THREE VILLAGES THREE CHURCHES

Another of our CTC graduates from Jali village



in Zomba, Pastor Geofry Madalitso, has been evangelizing in three different villages. His wife and four children are pictured here. The following photos demonstrate the fruit of his new ministry as he pastors three growing congregations.

The first photo, from Sunuzi village, is a pole building with a thatch roof. Note that there are only a handful of Bi-



bles. A Bible is a precious thing in Malawi and few believers have one.





The second location is in Makawa village where they have a brick building with a thatch roof.



The third building is located in Mlozi village and is a brick structure with no roof as yet.

I was literally blessed to tears of joy as I read the stories and looked at the humble photos, realizing that even during a year that I have not been able to travel, our CTC program continues to bear fruit as God works through our grads.

Thank you for standing with us and helping to make this happen. I suspect we will want to build a couple more churches very soon. Praise the Lord!
