## PRAISE GOD WE DID IT!



Last month I shared with you how we raised \$12,275 to put toward the roof for Pastor Samuel in Tete, Mozambique. Because the roof for their building is over seven times larger than the 30 ft. x 60 ft. structures we normally build, I felt it was important to send him at least \$20,000 to put toward the over \$32,000 the roof would cost. That roof is now under construction! The rest of the church (exterior walls and inside) will be completed once the congregation has finished paying their share of the roofing cost. At least they will be under roof and able to hold services. Thank U!

I also challenged you to "Arise and Build" two new churches in Malawi. These buildings will also become training center locations for our CTC pastoral training program. I am blessed to report that the \$20,000 requested for these two buildings has come in and they also are under construction!

I posted on my Facebook page a video of Pastor Dennis Chaima from the Chiradzulu dis-

trict and his congregation worshipping the Lord in the open during a rainstorm after their church had collapsed. This is not something one would likely ever see in the USA, but indictive of their zeal for the Lord.

Once I was able to release the funds for the building, Stephen Tambuli, our CTC director in that part of Malawi, sent me some photos of women carrying heavy stone on their heads to the site of the new building. The



stones were then broken into smaller and smaller pieces with a hammer and chisel for the onsite hand mixing of



the cement for the foundation, also something one is not likely to see taking place here in the USA.

These women are from the congregation of the church and will be students in the CTC program



once the church building is ready. You can see from these photos that the form of the church is beginning to take shape. Please keep both churches in your prayers.







However, all the work of hauling bags of cement, steel, and wood for the roofing has come at a cost for our truck. Stephen Tambuli is asking for help getting the truck repaired so we can continue to help with the

church construction. We need about \$500 to cover burst shock absorbers, worn out clutch and pressure plates, and ball joints. Please mark your gift "Truck."
