**Catching up while in Ecuador** 

I'm actually writing this on April 18th because we are planning to be out of the USA from May 24th through June 24th. During that time Vicky and Daniel will be in Ecuador where she will help with her parent's ministry and Daniel will make regular visits to the children's park across the street. I will be teaching some in Ecuador, and **if all goes well**, a week in Peru with the Swai Inidans who are going through the CTC program. I needed to do the June newsletter well ahead of that so Jim and Kerry Warner can put it together and take it to the post office for mailing. I wanted to spend this issue bringing you up to date on some events that I think will encourage you.

## VIETNAM

Vietnam has always had a soft spot in my heart as that is where this ministry was birthed. I invested much of the first 3 years of this ministry training 12 young Vietnamese. Several of them have worked together to continue the CTC program overcoming many difficulties along the way. We continue to help them as funds are available, but they also do much to help. Our director is encouraged by her sister (Sara not her real name) who lives in the USA and who is even now teaching a group of students via Zoom due to Covid restrictions in Vietnam. One part of our ministry in the north has been to drug addicts who are trying to turn their lives around. Sara sent me the following email this past week:

Dear RevC. I send you the documentary film Walking Through The Valley Of The Shadow Of Death from Vietnam (three episodes). The drug addicts in this documentary film 95% are our students in the CTC Bible class... After they were drug free, they were sent to our Bible class. We have taught them from the book of Genesis to the book of Revelation for four years. Now some become pastors and leaders of the churches or rehab centers or leaders of small groups.

Previously, the local government did not allow them to open a center to treat drug addicts. They cut off electricity and water and persecuted them. In the past time, there were many addicts who broke the camp and marched on the streets of

VN, only wearing underwear and the government was powerless to do anything because the addicts were the ones who risked their lives to do whatever they want to do. The authorities recently went to the rehab center to make this documentary because they saw success in treating addicts. And the film was shown on TV for the whole country to see and even in the press of Vietnam. The number of viewers is very high.

The filmmakers including the editor, the director and the cameraman converted to Jesus Christ in secret with the pastor. This film was nominated for the national competition for best documentary. And they want to translate into English to take the international exam. I can't believe this things happened.

I hope that when you watch this film, you will be encouraged because you see the power of God and know that your hard work is not in vain.

**Note**: The person who knelt down on the floor set free from drug and cancer. The drug addicts came to my class, I allowed them to lie down to study the Bible because they had no strength at that time. Right now I am teaching on zoom for them and others... May God bless you and your family abundantly. Take care. Love.

The first of the three-part documentary features personal testimonies of both addicts and their parents. It still brings tears to my eyes when I see what God has done with these courageous young people who risked their own lives to teach others about living with Christ. Now even the communist welcome their help as lives are being transformed.

of the church has finally begun after several delays. Here is a recent photo of the progress. Pastor Samuel reported to me that they now

have satellite congregations in **11 other locations** as far away as **270 miles**, one of which is even in Malawi. He included a few photos of their evangelistic efforts and wanted us to know that they had baptized another group of 67 in water from the main church in Tete. Another of our investments that is paying rich dividends for the Kingdom of our Lord! Keep them in prayer!
