#### Giving Guidelines for 2024

In last month's newsletter, I mentioned some recommendations our tax expert suggested we follow to avoid any issues with the IRS. The following guidelines will protect your giving so that you can receive tax reduction contribution credit that will stand up to IRS giving rules.

**It is best NOT to write anything on the memo line of your check.** If you do, it needs to be very general in nature, such as "where needed most" or "project, Malawi." I will always do my best to honor your wishes. If you want to make your intention very clear, we suggest you leave the memo line blank and put a note in the envelope along with your check and send it directly to me.

Missionary Ventures prefers to only handle contributions toward our personal support from which they deduct 5%. I appreciate MVI and understand the cost involved with doing the bookkeeping. They do keep a project account for me and do not collect any fee from project money sent to them for ITM. To help reduce their cost of doing ministry, please **send project support directly to me in Land O Lakes or to our PO Box in Oldsmar.**

For personal support to my family, **leave the memo line blank** and use any of the following three methods: Use MVI postage paid return envelope, check payable to MVI **or** check payable to ITM and send directly to REVC **or** to the PO Box. All contributions made to ITM or MVI will receive a year-end tax reduction contribution receipt shortly after the new year begins.

Please continue to stand with us and consider what you can do extra for ITM as you make sure your year of tithing and offerings are up to date.

To sum up, here are the key things to remember:

**1. Please send all project gifts to RevC's home address or the PO BOX. Put a separate note inside to indicate the project.**

RevC's address-make checks payable to ITM: **ITM, 3503 Chessington Drive, Land O Lakes, FL 34638**

**OR**

P.O. Box address-checks payable to ITM: **ITM, P.O. Box 958, Oldsmar, FL 34677**

**2. For RevC support, use any method.** No need to put anything on the memo line nor put a note inside.

**3. You can also give online at [www.revc.org](http://www.revc.org) with a credit card or PayPal. Credit card fee + MVI 5% will be deducted if with a credit card; PayPal fees apply if through PayPal.**

The Holy Spirit moved and over 50 people came to faith in Jesus Christ, among which were some of the pastors and many Muslims. As of now, we have **\$1800** of the **\$10,000** we need. Please do what you can to help.

I wanted to give you a report with photos on what we are doing among the Fulani people in Nigeria. We put a roof on a school building and now there are over 100 children going to school! We also are helping to build a house for the missionary that is doing this work. Pictures in February, the Lord willing!
