Malawi: The Day of Days



Let me begin by saying that there is only one name given among men by which we must be saved! To God the Father be all the Glory for the gift of our Lord Jesus Christ. I take no credit or glory for what God did on this day. I only pray with tears that I can in some way convey to you the majesty of our God and the power in the anointing of His Word upon His servant. This was a day of days when God moved in such a mighty way upon me that I was fully aware that God had taken over and I was only the mouthpiece. Such anointing was upon me that I could barely keep up with what God was saying and I knew that I knew instantly that TO-**DAY WAS THE DAY OF SALVATION** for many who had gathered to hear the white missionary teacher. I was so aware that it was HIM and not me that even now as I try to type this report, I can barely see the screen for the tears that are flowing from my eyes. I feel the awesome responsibility of trying to communicate what I have only rarely experienced. Four times already I have had to go and gather myself before returning to this laptop. It has been five days since that Wednesday, and it still overwhelms me to the point I feel powerless and am as nothing in His presence in this room. He is such an awesome God, and I am so grateful for the opportunity to serve HIM. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for your goodness to me a sinner saved by such GRACE that I cannot find words to give you the GLORY that you alone deserve. You are the ONE true LIVING God and beside youTHERE IS NO OTHER!



This was the day of the pastors' conference and Stephen, Howard, and I left Blantyre for Chipwere village in the bush. Because our pickup truck's radiator had overheated on Tuesday, we took the flatbed truck and headed for the bush. About an hour into the trip this truck also began to overheat. We knew instantly that it was an attack

from the enemy who did not want us to get to our destination. Fortunately, we broke down at a place where we were able to find someone who had a small bottle of coolant. Before long we were back on our way but now about an hour behind schedule. Those who had gathered would likely have been waiting for a couple

of hours before we arrived.
Upon our arrival a group of about eight
Muslim women were singing to
Allah for our welcome. I
knew the enemy was wanting me to know



that he was fully present and ready to battle. There were at least 40 pastors on the ground under a straw shelter to shield them from the sun and behind them under the shade of a very large tree were well over 100 other men, women, and children sitting on the ground.

I had prepared and spent considerable time reviewing 20 pages of printed CTC material for the pastors' con-



ference and had two hours to teach. However, that morning the Holy Spirit told me that what I had brought was not the right material. I was directed to other CTC material and had about 30

minutes to look it over. It meant that I needed to take my laptop which fortunately had a brand-new battery. I turned to the material, prayed, and began to teach. Many of the pastors were taking notes and I could tell they were receiving instruction. Only Pastor Andrew Munama, our CTC graduate, had ever been to a Bible school. After almost an hour of teaching, I suddenly felt the presence of the **ONE** who lives in me fill me with His presence. I knew that I was to immediately lead into a presentation of the gospel instead of finishing the rest of the conference material. This evangelistic message was in my heart, and I did not need any notes. I began with creation through the fall of man in the garden, the separation of the human spirit from God

(God's definition of death), the promise of the Redeemer, man's animal sacrifices for sin that could only cover over not take away our sin, the birth of Jesus. I continued with His reason for coming and our need for salvation. There were times when I was speaking to

everyone but addressing either the pastors or the congregation under the tree. There was such a presence of the Holy Spirit working that I could hardly say the words in my



mouth fast enough! Even Howard, my translator, struggled at times to keep up. God was moving!

When it came time to provide the opportunity to make a choice **many many** hands went up. I realized that some were already saved due to the ministry of Pastor Andrew and were most likely responding due to unconfessed sin in their lives. I took a few moments to explain that for the Christian sin breaks our fellowship with God. We are still His children, however, and that is why we need to confess our sin, repent, and ask for His forgiveness which He then gives.

After that I gave another opportunity for those who raised their hands for the first time to stand to their feet as a sign of their confession of faith in the sacrifice of Jesus for their sin. I explained that standing for Jesus was vital because Jesus said, "If you will confess me before your fellow man, I will confess you before the Father in heaven; but if you do not confess Me before your fellowman I will not confess you before the Father." Well over 50 people stood at once including several of the men who had come for the pastors' conference. It was a powerful move of God and angels were rejoicing in heaven! God had dealt the enemy a crushing blow as there were many former Muslims among those standing! I led them in a prayer of salvation and prayed a blessing over them. God is sooooo GOOD!! There were too many to even get in this next photo!

Stephen and Pastor Andrew were so excited as well because they recognized the strong anointing, that this



was not just RevC. However, we now have a problem and need your help! This small building is what Pastor Andrew has for a church. If just the people who were saved today came, they would likely not fit in this build-

ing. It needs to be torn down or added to with a new
